64,320 patrons came through the doors at the East Roswell Library in 2016—that's more than the total population of the City of Alpharetta, Dunwoody or Marietta! Our library has become an established community center, offering myriad resources for East Roswell's diverse constituencies.

Our patrons checked out more than **166,500 items** (books, cd's, dvd's) in 2016.

Did you notice the "run" on books in our Children and Teen Sections this summer? Again, **more than 850 children** participated in the library's Summer Reading program.

7,367 adults and youth attended programs at the library during the past year.
